All applicants must meet these eligibility guidelines:

- Be a high school senior, high school graduate or current college student;
- Exhibit potential for successful completion of course of study;
- Participate in at least 1 Barrel Bash event between May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019

The criteria for awarding the scholarships are as follows:

Scholarship (20 points)

- (1) Academic performance and honors
- (2) Rank in class

Demonstrate an interest in agriculture, agribusiness or the equine industry (10 points)

Financial need (15 points)

Organization participation/Activities & Demonstrated Leadership (20 points)

Character and personality (20 points)

- (1) Maturity
- (2) Industriousness and motivation
- (3) Intellectual interest
- (4) Moral character
- (5) Sportsmanship

Overall Essay Composition & Thoroughness (15 points)
